RULES: PARENTS & STUDENTS

Regularity and punctuality are essential for every Balavikas student. If the student is going to be late or absent, it is the parents' responsibility to inform the teacher or Balavikas coordinator the day before the class about the absence. If the child has frequent absenteeism, he/she may be requested to re-register for the next semester.

Once registered, children will go through the entire program for the day. We encourage the children to wear Indian clothes. It is important children are in comfortable clothes for yoga classes.

Parents are encouraged to sit in the class with their children or attend adult classes at the Temple if organized, till the Balvikas classes end. Parents are encouraged to work as volunteers for Balavikas classes if requested.

Parents and students shall park cars only in the main parking lot and leave the shoes at assigned places.

Parent's help is needed in maintaining the discipline of their children. If the teacher encounters any problem with the student's behavior, he/she will report to the Balavikas coordinator who will follow up with the parents. Under those circumstances, from then on, a parent may be asked to attend the class with the child.

If the parents have any problem with the teachers, they will bring it to the attention of the Balavikas coordinator who will follow up with the teacher and inform the Board representative. The matter will be reviewed and appropriate action will be taken.

Parents shall be responsible for the safety of the child at all times from and to the class. Parents and students shall follow all the rules as prescribed by the Board.

During any dispute, Balavikas coordinator and the HTSA board will be the final authority.

The Board will review the rules on a regular basis and will revise them as needed.
